

GARBAGE/RECYCLING CART INQUIRIES

My garbage cart is broken – what do I do?

Please contact the Village Office at 989-1589, and we will be happy to place a work order with Advanced Disposal to repair or replace your garbage cart. Please provide a detailed description of damage when calling.

How do I go about getting a different size of garbage cart? It's too small (or too big) for my household's needs!

Please contact the Village Office at 989-1589, and we will be happy to place a work order with Advanced Disposal to swap out your existing cart and provide you with the correct size.

Garbage Cart Sizes:

- **35 Gallon Roll Cart** – 85 pound weight limit – holds approx. 3 tall kitchen bags
- **60 Gallon Roll Cart** – 135 pound weight limit – holds approx. 4 tall kitchen bags
- **90 Gallon Roll Cart** – 175 weight limit – holds approx. 5 tall kitchen bags

Cart changes are pro-rated (miscellaneous billing sent to you from Village), and then cart cost is put on pre-pay with the tax roll.

Recycling Cart Size:

- **96 Gallon Roll Cart** - Only one (1) size offered; cost is pre-payment with the tax roll.



YARD WASTE SITE

Where is the site located?

It is located at the southeast corner of the Village (corner of Military and Kesler Roads).

What are rules?

The Yard Waste site accepts yard waste only! No plastic of any kind, including garbage bags. "Dump" grass clippings, leaves, and small branches on the pile. Do not leave plastic bags in or around dumping area. No branches greater than 4 inches in diameter by 4 feet in length are accepted. Any items larger than stated should be disposed at your own expense (you may contact our local waste carrier).

Landscaping material, rocks, bricks, t-posts, etc. are prohibited! Please take your plastic bags!!!

What are the site's hours of operation?

The hours of operation vary in accordance with its seasonal schedule, so please contact the Village Office, go online at www.villageofsherwood.org, or visit our Facebook page for current dates and times of operation.

GARBAGE COLLECTION BASICS

Who does the Village use for garbage and recycling collection?

The Village of Sherwood uses contractor, **Advanced Disposal**, for our garbage and recycling needs. You can contact them at 1 (888) 688-4005.

When is garbage collected in the Village?

- **Garbage is collected every Friday morning at 6 AM.**
- **EXCEPTION** - When there is holiday during the week – pick-up is on the following day (Saturday).
- **WE RECOMMEND** placing your cart out at curbside the night before to ensure timely pick-up.

How do I tend to the garbage in my cart?

Regular garbage is to be in a plastic bag securely closed in cart. Refuse must be confined in cart (additional bags or other canisters will not be picked up).

Are there special collections for the items that our garbage collector doesn't pick up regularly (i.e. large [bulk] items, hazardous waste materials, electronics, and medication disposal)?

The Village of Sherwood's website and Village quarterly newsletter contain all of the scheduled events and special locations for such collections. If you **need** to use a landfill, contact:

RECYCLING COLLECTION BASICS

When is recycling collection scheduled?

Recycling collection is scheduled the same date and time of garbage collection. Recycling collection is collected **bi-weekly** (split from West Side and East Side of Village). General dividing line is Stommel Road (Past Stommel Road – Lake Winnebago = West, Stommel Road – Rest of Village = East). Check the map on our website for specifics or call the Village Office.

How do I properly recycle in the Village?

PLACE ALL RECYCLABLES LOOSE IN THE RECYCLING BIN OR CART.



Utilize your property's designated recycling canister (**blue top roll cart**) to recycle your products. Items do not need to be bundled or placed in clear plastic bags – just rinse items (if needed), break down cardboard, and place in receptacle for pick-up.

Common recycling mistakes...

Items that cannot be recycled by Advanced Disposal (please throw out in trash or reuse if possible): plastic grocery bags, takeout containers and donut boxes, polystyrene (Styrofoam), pizza boxes, household glass (mirrors, light bulbs, dishes, and window panes), wet paper, baby diapers, ceramics and pottery, paint, scrap metals, and hypodermic needles.

Other items such as pesticides, automotive fluids, diesel fuel, gasoline, kerosene, aerosol cans, car batteries, and automotive parts can be recycled during a Calumet County offered recycling event. Check the Village newsletter for current or upcoming opportunities.

WHAT IS RECYCABLE?

PAPER PRODUCTS

ACCEPTED ITEMS: Newspaper & Inserts
Cardboard
Junk Mail
Office Paper
Milk, Juice, & Soup Cartons
Phonebooks, Books, Magazines, & Catalogs

DISPOSAL GUIDELINES: Place shredded paper in bag, secure, and label.

NOT ACCEPTED: No paper contaminated by food/grease
No Tissues or Tissue Paper
No Gift Wrap

GLASS, METAL, & CARTONS

ACCEPTED ITEMS: Aluminum Bottles & Cans
Steel, Tin, & Bi-Metal Cans
Food & Beverage Glass Bottles & Jars

DISPOSAL GUIDELINES: Empty and rinse all bottles and containers; remove and discard all screw caps.

NOT ACCEPTED: No Aluminum Pans
No Aerosol Cans
No Foil
No Empty Paint Cans

PLASTICS

ACCEPTED ITEMS: All Plastic Bottles & Containers for Produce, Bakery, & Deli (Labeled #1-7)
Soda, Water, & Other Drink Bottles
Dairy Containers & Lids
Food & Household Bottles, Jars, & Jugs

DISPOSAL GUIDELINES: Empty and rinse all bottles and containers; remove and discard all screw caps.

NOT ACCEPTED: No Plastic Bags of any Kind
No Wrap or Film
No Motor Oil Bottles
No Styrofoam of Any Kind
