

REQUIRED BUILDING INSPECTIONS

1. Footing and foundation wall inspection, including tar, tile and stone backfill.
2. Porch/deck additions/changes of more than 2' off ground. Garage additions. Light, ventilation, window size changes.
3. Rough-in inspections required on following trades:
 - General construction, including structural framing, insulation
 - Electrical rough-ins
 - Plumbing rough-ins
 - HVAC rough-ins
4. Final inspection must be made after the dwelling is completed which ascertains that no violations exist that could reasonably affect the health and safety of the dwelling occupants.
5. Effective June 1, 1995, the following contractors are required to be licensed/registered through the State of Wisconsin by the Department of Industry, Labor & Human Relations:
 - General Construction Contractors – HVAC Contractors – Plumbers
6. If you have any questions regarding license/certification requirements, you may contact the Madison District Office at 608-266-3151 during normal business hours for further information regarding this subject matter.
7. All electrical work must comply with the requirements of the Wisconsin Electrical Code, Volume 2 and the National Electrical Code.
8. The State Building Code requires a 48 hour inspection notice. The notice excludes Saturdays, Sundays, and all major holidays.
