MUNICIPAL CODE REMINDERS

GENERAL LANDSCAPING & MAINTENANCE REQUIREMENTS

- **YARD MAINTENANCE (§ 22-65):** Pursuant to Wisconsin Statutes, Section 66.96 and Section 7-10f of the Village Municipal Code, notice is hereby given to each person who owns, occupies, or controls land in the Village of Sherwood, Calumet County, WI to DESTROY ALL NOXIOUS WEEDS AND CUT RANK GROWTH on such property. **Noxious weeds** are: Canada Thistle, Leafy Spurge, Field Bindweed (Creeping Jenny), Lythrum (Purple Loosestrife), and Multiflora Rose. Rank growth includes lawns, grasses, and other vegetative growth on undeveloped lots or **platted parcels of land which exceed eight (8) inches in length** except for property in designated floodplain, wetland, or storm water detention areas. **If you fail to comply to the parcel vegetative height allowance, a subcontractor will destroy all weeds and rank growth at the expense of the owner and said charges (costs associated with subcontractor plus Village municipal fees, which are more severe for each offense) shall be rolled to tax roll if left unpaid.**

PUBLIC NUISANCES AFFECTING PEACE & SAFETY

- **DEBRIS (§ 7-12, Q):** Any construction debris or materials, unsightly debris, trash, wood, bricks; construction debris shall be contained within adequately sized dumpsters placed on site. For residential structures, this shall occur immediately after placement of the home's roof trusses.
- **STREET SWEEPING (§ 7-12, K[1]):** Construction, demolition or other worksite are required to maintain a street free from mud, gravel, or other obstructions at the end of each workday.
- **LOUD & UNNECESSARY NOISE PROHIBITED (§ 7-14, A[7]):** (Construction or repair of buildings.) The erection (including excavation), demolition, alteration, or repair of any building, as well as the operation of any pile driver, stern shovel, pneumatic hammer, derrick, steam or electric hoist, or any other similar equipment attended by loud or unusual noise, other than between the hours of 7:00 AM and 10:00 PM on weekdays.

MUNICIPAL CODE 22-111 – PUBLIC NUISANCES OFFENDING MORALS & DECENCY

- **POTABLE RESTROOM REQUIRED (§ 7-11, F):** Public urination and defecation. It shall be unlawful for any person to urinate or defecate outdoors in any area open to public view. It shall be required that any construction, demolition, or other worksite where private or public restrooms are not available shall have potable, properly maintained restrooms on site for the duration of the project, or in the case of residential and commercial construction, final occupancy is given.
