2024 Annual Refuse and Recycle fees: 95 gallon cart = \$185

If your can is damaged during collection and requires repair or replacement, please call the Village office to make arrangements at no cost. If a can is damaged through misuse (i.e. hot ashes) or lost, the homeowner is responsible for the replacement cost.

Bulk Item Pick-Up: Our annual bulk item curbside pick-up dates are May 7-8.

Recycling Guidelines: Put items loosely in cart, no bags needed.

Plastics: all food, beverage and household bottles, jars and jugs, dairy containers and lids, deli, bakery, and produce containers and lids.

Paper: Newspapers and inserts, cardboard, food boxes without grease, junk mail, catalogs, office and school papers, milk, juice and soup cartons, phonebooks, books, and magazines.

Metals: aluminum bottles and cans, steel, tin, and bi-metal cans, empty aerosol cans, no need to remove labels.

Glass: Food/beverage bottles and jars, including metal caps and lids.

YARD WASTE SITE INFORMATION

The Village operates a yard waste location at the intersection of Kessler and County M roads (on your right past the Granary Supper Club).

Hours of operation:

April: Weather permitting—call Village Office to inquire, or check our website.

MAY-OCTOBER

Tues and Thurs: 2pm-6pm

Saturdays: 8am-3pm

Sundays: 9am-Noon

November: First 2 Weekends

ACCEPTABLE ITEMS: Brush trimmings, grass clippings, leaves, weeds, branches, pumpkins.

UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS: all bags (even biodegradable), garbage, roots, rocks, stones, bricks, t-posts, clay, soil, or sod.

Includes: One 95-gallon yard waste curbside cart for weekly pick-up
